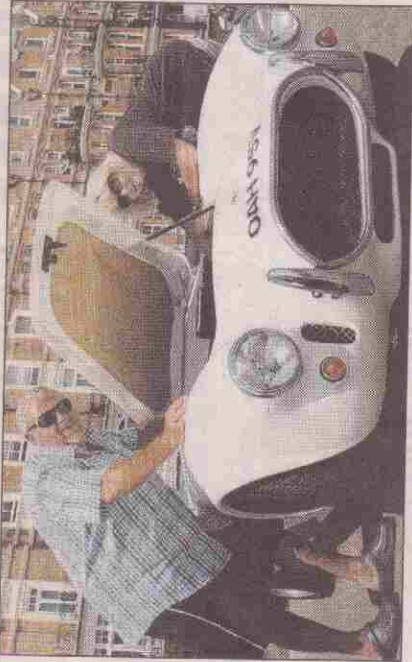


## Motorists shine in summer classic car display beside The Old Bathing Station

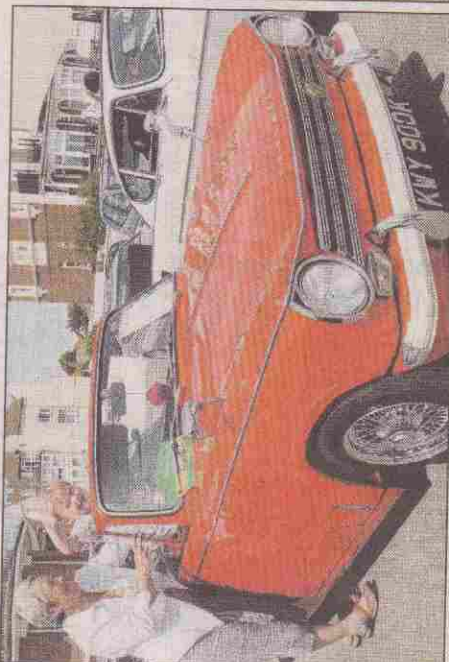
A spokesman for the club said they were "delighted" Bexhill Museum had let the car out again, adding: "all
